# SYNOPSIS:

This kit contains the parts needed to install a backup alarm / strobe light kit on S20 machines equipped with the optional overhead guard (machines serial numbers 001318 and below only). Please follow step-by-step instructions.

## SPECIAL TOOLS / CONSIDERATIONS: NONE

(Estimated time to complete: 1.5 hours)

#### PREPARATION:

1. Park the machine on a clean level surface, turn off the machine, remove the key, and set the parking brake.

FOR SAFETY: Before leaving or servicing machine, stop on level surface, turn off machine, and remove key.

- 2. Open the main cover.
- 3. Disconnect the battery cables from the battery.



WARNING: Always disconnect battery cables from machine before working on electrical components.

## **INSTALLATION:**

- 1. Use a pan screw (5), a lock washer (7), and a hex nut (6) to install the finger clip (4) onto the horn bracket (19). Refer to Fig. 1.
- 2. Insert the flasher (8) into the finger clip (4). Refer to Fig. 1.
- Use the hardware included with the spot light (15) to install the spot light onto the horn bracket (19). Refer to Fig. 1.

4. Use two hex screws (2) and two hex nuts (3) to install the backup alarm (1) onto the horn bracket (19). Refer to Fig. 1.



 Use two hex screws (20), two flat washers (21), and two hex nuts (22) to install the light / alarm assembly assembled in the previous several steps onto the overhead guard. Refer to Fig. 2.



- 6. Trim the flashing light wires (16) to 6".
- 7. Crimp a bullet terminal (26) onto each flashing light (16) wire.

8. Route the flashing light (16) cable through the hole in the overhead guard and use two pan screws (17), two flat washers (13), and two hex nuts (18) to install the light onto the guard. Refer to Fig. 3.



- 9. Connect the alarm / strobe harness (23) to the flashing light (16). Refer to Fig. 3 and Fig. 4.
- Connect the alarm / strobe harness (23) to the backup alarm (1), spot light (15), and flasher (8). Refer to Fig. 1 and Fig. 4.



- 11. Cut the vinyl duct (24) into one 28" section and two 10" sections.
- 12. Install the sections of vinyl duct (24) cut in the previous step onto the overhead guard. Refer to Fig. 5, Fig. 6, and Fig. 7.

13. Route the alarm / strobe harness (23) through the sections of vinyl duct, down between the main cover and frame of the machine, and connect the alarm / strobe harness to the main wire harness. Refer to Fig. 4, Fig. 8, and Fig. 13.



14. Open and close the main cover several times to ensure the cable is not being pinched when the cover is closed.

15. Remove the floor plate from the operator compartment. Set the floor plate and hardware aside Refer to Fig. 9.



- 16. Connect the main wire harness to the switch (9). Refer to Fig. 12.
- 17. Wrap electrical tape around the main wire harness / switch (9) connections from the previous step. No metallic parts should touch the connections. Contact with other metallic parts could cause the system to short and the alarm and lights will not operate.
- 18. Remove the nut from the switch (9).
- 19. Holding the switch (9), reach through the open floor, insert the switch into hole in front of the directional pedal, and thread the nut onto the switch to secure the switch into place. Refer to Fig. 10.



20. Hook the spring (10) to the switch (9). Refer to Fig. 11.

NOTE: It is not necessary to remove the propel pedal to install items shown in Fig. 11. The exploded view is used to better illustrate how the parts are assembled onto the machine.



- 21. Hook the chain (11) onto the other end of the spring (10). Refer to Fig. 6.
- 22. Slide the sleeve (25) onto the spring (10) and chain (11). Refer to Fig. 6.
- 23. Use a pan screw (12), flat washer (13), and hex nut (14) to install the chain (11) onto the directional pedal. Refer to Fig. 6.
- 24. Reinstall the floor plate into the operator compartment. Refer to Fig. 9.
- 25. Reconnect the battery cables to the batteries.
- 26. Start and test the machine. Operate the machine in reverse and ensure all lights and the alarm function.






