NOTE: Numbers in parenthesis () are reference numbers for parts listed in Bill of Materials.


Installation instructions for kit number 9008707

SYNOPSIS:

This kit contains the parts needed install the optional Pre-Sweep assembly onto T16 scrubbers. Please follow step-by-step instructions.



PREPARATION:

1. Park the machine on a clean level surface, turn off the machine, and remove the key.

FOR SAFETY: Before leaving or servicing machine, stop on level surface, turn off machine, and remove key.

2. Disconnect the battery cables from the batteries.




INSTALLATION:

1. Remove the head headlight disk and grommet from the front shroud. discard the headlight disk and grommet. Refer to Fig. 1.


Machines equipped with optional headlight only: Remove the headlight assembly from the front shroud. Discard the headlight assembly. Refer to Fig. 1.

- 2. Pull the main wire harness Pre-Sweep connectors through the hole in the front shroud where the light or disk were previously installed. (Fig. 1)
- Use three SEMS M10 hex screws (3) and one M10 hex nut (4) to install the right Pre-Sweep mounting plate (1) to the frame of the machine. (Fig. 1)
- Use three SEMS M10 hex screws (3) and one M10 hex nut (4) to install the left Pre-Sweep mounting plate (2) to the frame of the machine. (Fig. 1)
- 5. Position the Pre-Sweep assembly (11) near the front of the machine. (Fig. 1)
- 6. Connect the Pre-Sweep harness to the main wire harness. (Fig. 1 / Fig. 3)
- 7. Push the Pre-Sweep assembly (11) against the front of the machine.
- 8. Use six SEMS M10 hex screws (3) to install the Pre-Sweep assembly (11) onto the right and left Pre-Sweep mounting plates (1) (2) installed in the previous two steps. (Fig. 1)



- 9. Remove the hardware holding the console panel to the front shroud and carefully pull the console panel from the shroud. Do not break any wire / cable connections when pulling the console panel from the front shroud. Set the hardware aside. (Fig. 2)
- 10. Insert the rocker switch (5) into the console panel. (Fig. 2)
- 11. Connect the main harness to the rocker switch. (Fig. 2 / Flg. 3 / Fig. 5)
- 12. Reinstall the console panel onto the front shroud. (Fig. 2)
- 13. Remove the hardware holding the electrical panel to the steering channel weldment and carefully remove the electrical panel from the steering channel weldment. Do not break any wire / cable connections when pulling the electrical panel from the steering channel weldment. Set the hardware aside. (Fig. 2)
- 14. Install the 25-Amp circuit breaker (6) onto the electrical panel (CB 19). (Fig. 2)
- 15. Insert the 15-Amp circuit breaker (8) into the electrical panel (CB 16). (Fig. 2)

- Install a circuit breaker boot (9) onto the 15-Amp circuit breaker (8) installed in the electrical plate. (Fig. 2)
- Connect the main harness to the 25-Amp circuit breaker (6) and 15-Amp circuit breaker (8). (Fig. 2 / Fig. 3 / Fig. 4 / Fig. 5)
- 18. Reinstall the electrical panel onto the steering channel weldment. (Fig. 2)
- Insert the 20-Amp circuit breaker (7) into (CB 8) and the 2.5-Amp circuit breaker (10) into (CB 3) in the circuit breaker mounting plate located in the battery compartment. (Fig. 2)
- 20. Install a circuit breaker boot (9) onto the 20-Amp circuit breaker (7) and 2.5-Amp circuit breaker (10) installed in the circuit breaker mounting plate. (Fig. 2)
- Connect the main harness to the 20-Amp circuit breaker (7) and the 2.5-Amp circuit breaker (10) installed in the circuit breaker mounting plate. (Fig. 2 / Fig. 5 / Fig. 6)










- 22. Reconnect the battery cables to the batteries.
- 23. Start the machine, raise the Pre-Sweep to fully raised position, and turn off the machine.
- 24. Install the disk side brushes and cylindrical main brush into the Pre-Sweep assembly. Refer to the *MAINTENANCE* section in the Operator Manual for installation instructions.
- 25. Install the vacuum debris bag into the Pre-Sweep assembly. Refer to *EMPTY THE PRE-SWEEP DEBRIS HOPPER* in the Operator Manual for installation instructions.
- 26. Start and test the machine. Operate the Pre-Sweep assembly to ensure it functions. Refer to the Operator Manual for additional information about operating the Pre-Sweep assembly.
